



**Position: Part Time Mobile Clinic Veterinarian**

**Department: Operations**

Exempt/Non-Exempt: Exempt, Per Diem, Part Time Position

Part time veterinarians will work **two days per week** between Monday and Thursday, typically 8AM to 4PM.

**Immediate Supervisor:** Medical Manager

**Availability:** The Brother Wolf mobile spay and neuter clinic conducts high volume spay and neuter surgeries four days a week, typically traveling outside of Buncombe County one day per week. The mobile clinic veterinarian will conduct these surgeries and must be available in accordance with the clinic schedule.

**General Position Summary:**

The mobile clinic veterinarian will be responsible for providing leadership and direction to the mobile unit veterinary staff, and overseeing medical care for animals receiving services on the mobile unit. The primary responsibilities include performing spay/neuter surgeries and monitoring the health of treated animals.

**Essential Function/Major Responsibilities:**

- Perform scheduled spay/neuter surgeries each day
- Partner with Medical Manager and Mobile Clinic Coordinator to determine appropriate surgical schedule
- Oversee all aspects of assigned patients, including but not limited to: physical examination, surgery, pre- and post-operative care, anesthetic protocols, patient monitoring, emergency response, etc.
- Partner with Medical Manager to ensure that the clinic is appropriately stocked and staffed
- Respond to medical issues involving patients as necessary
- Act as manager-on-duty to support staff, offering guidance and instruction as needed
- Communicate any issues concerning staff or patients with Medical Manager
- Communicate issues regarding the clinic's disease control protocols, surgical protocols, or other medical items with Medical Manager
- Attend Mobile Clinic team meetings and Brother Wolf staff meetings

- Participate in relationships with community veterinarians, veterinary hospitals, and professional associations as requested
- Occasionally work in physically challenging conditions and be able to wear appropriate protective gear, including a protective mask

**Requirements:**

- DVM from accredited university
- Must hold or be able to obtain valid NC veterinary license prior to employment
- Must have current DEA license or be eligible to obtain a DEA license

**Required Skills:**

- Commitment and enthusiasm towards our mission of reducing pet overpopulation and improving the lives of animals in the community
- Fosters a positive work environment
- Willing to provide guidance and training to staff as needed
- Works with the Medical Manager to strengthen protocols and procedures as needed
